A: As part of their job description, hospitality aides can be assigned to one-on-one duty to address the specific needs of a resident.

In Cascade, we were caring for a person who became upset if they thought they were being closely monitored. A creative and thoughtful nurse in Cascade advised the hospitality aid to sit nearby and read a book so she didn't look like she was watching the resident.

This is a good reminder that things may not always be what they seem. If

vou see something that doesn't appear to make sense, it is OK to ask the person directly to eliminate assumptions and negative thoughts that
