## Outdoor Visitor Agreement

### Please read:

To ensure that those who live here are able to continue receiving outdoor visitors, it is important that you read and accept the following agreement, based on Washington State Department of Health guidelines, and that you abide by these terms during your entire visit.

---

- For the safety of CHCC residents and staff, you will be **screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19**. If you know your COVID-19 status, you must attest to it.

- **Wearing a mask** or other face covering is required during the entire visit, unless you have a medical reason not to or unless you need to facilitate communication with a person who is deaf or hard of hearing. If you do not have a face mask, CHCC will provide a cloth mask to be used during your visit.

- **Alcohol-based hand rub** must be used upon entering and exiting the visitation area.

- You must **maintain 6 feet of physical distance** from others, including from the person you are here to visit. If any physical contact occurs between you and a resident, the visit may be immediately terminated and the resident may be placed in 14-day quarantine.

- **One outdoor visit per resident per week** is allowed. Additional visits may be offered if space becomes available.

- Visits can be **up to 30 minutes** from start to finish, including the time needed for screening.

- **Up to two people are allowed** to visit any one resident at any time. This includes children.

- Children younger than 12 are permitted. **You are responsible for supervising the child** and ensuring compliance with hand-washing, sanitizing, masking and distancing requirements.

- **Pets are not allowed** during outside visits at this time. However, pets continue to be welcome during window visual visits.

- You must **stay in designated visitation locations**.

- **No food or drink** is permitted during visits.

- You may bring **non-food gift items** to give to a resident, but the items must be **placed in a plastic bag** and left on the cart at the entrance.

- **CHCC may deny outdoor visitations** if circumstances appear to pose a risk of COVID-19 exposure or if the resident or visitor does not comply with infection control guidance.
