

DONOR BILL OF RIGHTS

The CHCC Foundation is committed to ethical fundraising, responsible stewardship and respectful relationships with those who support our mission. In alignment with the foundation's gift acceptance policy and donor recognition practices, donors have the following rights.



Donor rights

Donors have the right to:

- **Be informed of the foundation's mission and purpose** and how their gifts will be used to support educational training programs and the faith-based care provided at Christian Health Care Center in Lynden.
- **Have their gifts used as intended**, consistent with donor intent, applicable restrictions and the foundation's fiduciary responsibilities.
- **Receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition** for their contributions in accordance with CHCC's donor recognition practices, unless anonymity is requested.
- **Expect responsible stewardship** of their gifts, including prudent financial management, transparency and accountability.
- **Be assured that the foundation retains appropriate governance and control** over all charitable gifts, in compliance with IRS regulations and nonprofit best practices.
- **Receive honest and accurate information** about the foundation's activities, programs and financial stewardship.
- **Be treated with respect and professionalism** by foundation representatives, staff and volunteers.
- **Have personal information handled with care and confidentiality**, to the extent permitted by law.
- **Ask questions and receive timely, thoughtful responses** regarding gifts, recognition practices or foundation policies.
- **Decline recognition or request anonymity** without affecting the foundation's gratitude or stewardship of the gift.

Foundation commitment
